SchemaPlay—Raising outcomes through play

Schemes are patterns of thinking and behaviour that help children (and adults!) make sense of the world as they try to find out how things work.

Schemes are 'short cuts' for thinking about a collection of concepts and powerful motivators for repetitive action.

Schemes are visible in, and supported by, play.

In turn, play is supported and validated by an understanding of the research evidence underpinning schemes.

Building on schemes engages children in their learning and helps them develop more complex concepts and skills.

Are you observing children, for example, repeatedly:

- Deliberately dropping things?
- Moving things from one place to another?
- Constructing fences and barricades to enclose themselves or animals?
- Twirling and spinning around?
- Covering and hiding things?

You are seeing schemes in action! Come and learn how to more effectively support children and their play!
